DECLARATION OF KEVIN BECKWITH

I, Kevin Beckwith, state the following as my declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746:

1. I am over the age of 18 and competent to make this declaration.
2. I am a citizen of the United States and resident of the State of Arizona in Maricopa County.
3. I am a licensed attorney.
4. On November 8, 2022 (“Election Day”), I served as a Roving Attorney on behalf of the

Republican National Committee’s Election Integrity Program in Arizona. In that capacity, I visited four different vote centers in Maricopa County.

5. Three of the four vote centers that I visited had printer/tabulator issues.

Church of Jesus Christ of LDS Jomax

6. On Election Day, at approximately 12:20 p.m., I visited the Church of Jesus Christ of LDS Jomax vote center, located at 9543 W. Jomax Rd., Peoria, AZ 85383.

7. I observed both of the two tabulators consistently failing to operate and displaying the error code “ERR.” The Republican Poll Observer told me that these two failing tabulators rejected approximately 90% of ballots since voting began here at 6:00 a.m.

8. The line at this vote center was approximately 40 yards long and it had approximately 80 to 100 voters waiting in it to vote.

Glendale Community College – North (Chinle Building)

9. On Election Day at approximately 11:25 a.m., I visited the Glendale Community College – North (Chinle Building) vote center, located at 5727 W. Happy Valley Rd., Glendale, AZ 85310. I returned to this vote center at nearly 7:00 p.m. that day.

10. Republican Poll Observer Al Fields told me that one printer had not been operating for 1.5 hours (I observed that it was still not operating while I was there) and that another printer was not operating for one-half hour because it was out of ink.

11. Republican Poll Observer Fields told me that the tabulator had not been operating for one-half hour in the morning.

12. Republican Poll Observer Josh Haggard told me that someone dropped off “a mail basket” of ballots and that a poll worker said this drop-off was okay because the ballots were stamped.

13. Two people who were not in line by 7:00 p.m. dropped off ballots after 7:00 p.m. to poll workers who accepted the ballots.

14. The line at this vote center was approximately 50 yards long and it had approximately 100 to 120 voters waiting in it to vote.

Copper Hills Church

15. On Election Day at approximately 1:00 p.m., I visited the Copper Hills Church vote center, located at 27035 N. Black Rock Blvd., Peoria, AZ 85838.

16. Republican Poll Observer Kym Bystrom told me that both of the two tabulators and a printer were not operating for 1.5 hours earlier in the morning.

17. Republican Poll Observer Bystrom told me that the poll inspector carried spoiled ballots under her arm until she had about 50 spoiled ballots when she put them in a bag and Bystrom did not see them again.

18. Republican Poll Observer Bystrom told me that a man dropped off 10 ballots at once.

On November 10th @ aprox 9:30 am my husband and I went to Fountain Hills Community Center to vote. We received our ballots and filled them out (straight Republican ticket).

Both of us separately, had our ballots rejected by the scanner. We each tried multiple times, mine was rejected about 5 minutes before my husband finished and then his was also reject.

We were told both of our ballots had to be put in "Box 3" directly below the scanner. We are unsure how or if our ballots will be counted. We were given no other option than to place our unscanned ballot in Box 3.

I also witnessed another couple who were our age (50's) and also had both ballots rejected. They were irate and tried at least 3 machines none of which would accept the ballots.

The poll worker told me not to worry that this had been happening all morning and just to use Box 3. Based on this comment and the 10 minutes I waited and saw others having this issue in addition to myself and my husband, this issue appeared to be prevalent at this location on election day morning.

Many ballots were placed in Box 3 and not scanned.

DECLARATION OF Bradley D. Bettencourt

I, Bradley D. Bettencourt, state the following as my declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746:

1. I am a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Arizona.
 - A. I began my employment with Maricopa County Elections Department on October 17th, 2022 as a T-Tech. Attached as Exhibit A is a true and accurate copy of the email sent to me by the Maricopa County Elections Department describing my job responsibilities.
 - B. As a T-Tech, my duties prior to election day were setting up equipment at polling centers and site watching at early polling sites. Our focus as T-Techs was primarily on the Sitebooks, mofi, and printers (BOD and Lexmark). The tabulators were primarily handled by employees in other positions. I was not asked by Maricopa election officials to work with ballots in the tabulators. I, along with coworkers, set up Ascension Lutheran Church, Scottsdale Elks Lodge PBOE, and North Scottsdale UMC Church on 11/6/22. I, along with a coworker, set up Fort McDowell, the Islamic Center Scottsdale, and Mountain View Park Community Center on 11/7/22. Attached as Exhibit B is a true and accurate depiction of the work orders for pre-election set up.
 - C. Tabulator-
On Election Day, I was assigned to work at the First Baptist Chandler polling center as the onsite T-Tech. While I was standing by a tabulator that had been having issues misreading ballots, a woman (probably 50s or 60s) put her ballot in and the tabulator took it, but did not show the green check mark or say that it was successfully cast. The lady noticed this and I saw it. The lady was very concerned that her vote wouldn't count. The inspector called the hotline. She said the hotline told her to remove all the ballots from that tabulator. Then, they would start using that tabulator again at our site without counting the previously cast ballots. The previously cast ballots would be counted back at the main location, according to the inspector. The original misread issue that happened was with that same tabulator. It would say misread, spit the ballots back out, then we would reinsert the ballots into the second tabulator, which was able to read them.
 - D. I believed we fixed the problem in the morning. However, at the end of the day, the inspector told me they had continued to have misreads throughout the day. My first thought was they were not read well due to the way people voted after we fixed the original issue, but I can't confirm that. Some voters don't fill the oval in correctly. They do things like put a check mark in the oval that goes outside the oval by quite a bit.
 - E. Adjusting printer settings wasn't the main fix that I knew about, even though the statement by the Maricopa County Recorder's Office official Twitter page (2:08 PM Nov. 8, 2022), the Maricopa County official Twitter page (2:06 PM Nov. 8, 2022), and multiple local and national news outlets focused on county technicians changing printer settings as the solution. We shook the ink cartridges and cleaned the corona wire. Some T-Techs thought the tabulators really should have been reading better and some worried about whether votes dropped in "3" were actually counted. Some people adjusted printer settings, but it wasn't the primary fix that we were doing. On Election Day, the East

Valley T-Techs had a text message group. There were 15 employees in the group along with our supervisor from the Maricopa County Elections Department, Jose Luis Arballo. Attached as Exhibit C is a true and accurate depiction of the screenshots I took of these group text messages from Election Day, November 8, 2022.

F. Tabulator Key Issue- 11/14/22

This morning the driver said he had lost his key for the tabulator. He asked one of us to drive back since they drove the larger trucks to pick up equipment. Therefore, I drove back to MCTEC from the elementary school site to get a replacement key. At MCTEC, the man gave me 3 key rings "in case some keys get lost". I gave all 3 key rings to the driver upon returning to the elementary school and took a picture with him holding them.

No one asked me to sign for the keys or told me that he would have to sign to return the keys. They just handed me the keys. Additionally, the man who I gave the 3 key rings to would not have known I had 3 keys unless I gave all of them to him.


Attached as Exhibit D is a true and accurate copy of the photographs I took on November 14, 2022 when I delivered the keys to the driver. These photographs include the keys in my vehicle between MCTEC and the elementary school along with pictures of the driver holding the keys I had delivered to him.

G. Pick up- 11/9/22

The Ascension Lutheran administrator found a ballot in the church mailbox the day after the election. I texted our supervisor on what to do and did not receive a response on what to do.

My coworker, Martin, called our supervisor, Jose. Martin said that Jose told Martin to put the ballot in the envelope the drivers had. I taped a note to the ballot to confirm that it was found late in the church mailbox in addition to taking down the name. Then, we placed it in the envelope as Jose had recommended.

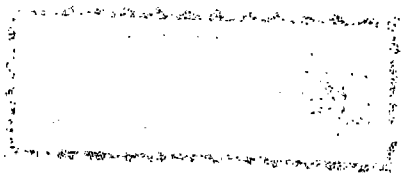
and less than 10% said yes to them. They would then ask us for the Republican voter guide.

I, Erin Botting, state the following as my declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746:

1. I am a citizen of The United States and a resident of the State of Arizona.

I am registered as a Republican.

I cast my vote at the Chandler/Gilbert Community College, in person, on Election Day, November 8, 2022.

I arrived around 10:30am and noted a long line outside. As I made my way to the line, there were two ladies handing out flyers (of some sort) trying to get the attention of anyone arriving.

While in line, a gentleman representing Andy Biggs was passing out leaflets about the Propositions. He asked everyone if they knew and understood what they were. I'm all in for Biggs, but I felt harassed as a voter. I did my Prop homework, had my sample ballot with me & was ready to go.

Next a "journalist" approached our line & wanted to talk to us - no one obliged. As I made my way through the doors, a lady who had been hanging around outside yelled out to everyone that she was running for a seat on the school board and to vote for her. She then laughed and said she was serious.

Once inside, I scanned my Az Driver's License - Error!
I then scanned my Voter ID Card - Error!
I asked one of the poll workers to help me. She scanned her badge, punched a few buttons, and "confirmed" my name and address without confirming my identity with Me! I held up my Arizona Driver's License and Voter ID to her, but she turned around and walked away without checking. This did not happen when I voted in August 2022.

Next, when I picked up my ballot, I was offered a black sharpie and noticed a cup full of black sharpies. I filled out my ballot with my own black ballpoint pen.

I knew and had heard about the Box 3 shenanigans and held my breath as I approached the boxes. There were only 2 boxes there and, to my dismay, both were labeled - Box 3. No other option was available.

I wanted to take my ballot and run, but I scanned it anyway, which seemed to take a minute too long, only to be confirmed by the reaction of the poll worker. He almost leapt for joy once my ballot was tabulated. I thought his reaction was weird, out of character, for a poll worker.

After that, I left and noticed the line outside had doubled and the two ladies were still at the entrances waving signs and handing out leaflets of some sort.

While driving home, I prayed. I kept saying over and over, it's in God's hands now.

I, Michael Brenner, state the following as my declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746:

1. I am over the age of 18 and competent to make this declaration.
2. I am a citizen of the United States and resident of the State of Arizona in Maricopa County.
3. I am a licensed attorney with “retired” status with the state bar.
4. On November 8, 2022 (“Election Day”), I served as a Roving Attorney on behalf of the

Republican National Committee’s Election Integrity Program in Arizona. In that capacity, I visited 11 different vote centers in Maricopa County.

5. Eight of the 11 vote centers that I visited had printer/tabulator issues.

Skyway Church – West Valley

6. On Election Day, at approximately 7:00 a.m. and again at approximately 2:15 p.m., I visited the Skyway Church – West Valley vote center, located at 14900 W. Van Buren St., Goodyear, AZ 85338.

7. The Republican Poll Observer told me that the printers ran out of ink not long after the opening of this vote center; that both of the two tabulators rejected 50% of ballots and shut down completely for one-half hour; and, that the technician could not fix the problem for one-half to 1 hour.

Compass Church

8. On Election Day, at approximately 7:45 a.m. and again at approximately 3:00 p.m., I visited the Compass Church vote center, located at 16060 W. Van Buren St., Goodyear, AZ 85338.

9. The Republican Poll Observer told me that one of the two tabulators rejected 100% of ballots; that, sporadically throughout the day, both of the two tabulators shut down completely; that, shortly after the opening of this vote center, both of the two printers shut down completely; that, sporadically throughout the day, both of the two printers printed ballots too light; and, that the Poll Inspector told voters to place their ballots into Door #3.

10. The Republican Poll Observer told me and I observed that the line at this vote center was between 45 and 60+ minutes long for most of the day.

Lifeway Church

11. On Election Day, at approximately 8:00 a.m., I visited the Lifeway Church vote center, located at 18926 W. Latham St., Buckeye, AZ 85326.

12. The Republican Poll Observer told me that, for about one half of the day (approximately six hours), both of the two tabulators were shut down completely; that both of the two printers only worked sporadically throughout the day; and, that at least three voters were turned away from this vote center and not given provisional ballots for having insufficient identification.

Youngker High School # 201

13. On Election Day, at approximately 8:20 a.m. and again at approximately 3:45 p.m., I visited the Youngker High School # 201 vote center, located at 3000 S. Apache Rd., Buckeye, AZ 85326.

14. Republican Poll Observer Nate told me that both of the two tabulators, both of the two printers, and all of the “kiosks” (check-in computers) were shut down completely; that poll workers turned away every voter and told each of them to go to some other vote center; that poll workers accepted mail-in ballot drop-off’s; that a technician delivered a new modem; that, at approximately 9:00 am, the tabulators and printers started working, but the tabulators rejected 90% of ballots; and, that at some point in the afternoon, one of the two tabulators again shut down completely.

15. The line at this vote center was approximately 45 minutes during my visit.

Church of Jesus Christ of LDS Buckeye

16. On Election Day, at approximately 8:30 a.m. and again at approximately 5:20 p.m., I visited the Church of Jesus Christ of LDS Buckeye vote center, located at 25800 W. Southern Ave., Buckeye, AZ 85326.

17. The Republican Poll Observer told me that “everything” (the tabulators, printers, and check-in computers) was shut down completely for 15 to 20 minutes; that the tabulators were “not reading” (rejecting) ballots; and, that one voter stuffed six mail-in ballots into the drop-off box.

Buckeye City Hall

18. On Election Day, at approximately 9:00 a.m., I visited the Buckeye City Hall vote center, located at 530 E. Monroe Ave., Buckeye, AZ 85326.

19. The Republican Poll Observer told me that “everything” (the tabulators, printers, and check-in computers) was shut down completely for 45 minutes; that one of the two tabulators was shut down completely for the entirety of the day; and, that the only one, other tabulator only worked sporadically throughout the day.

20. The line at this vote center was approximately 45 minutes long.

Estrella Mountain School/Goodyear

21. On Election Day, at approximately 9:30 a.m., I visited the Estrella Mountain School/Goodyear vote center, located at 10301 S. San Miguel Dr., Goodyear, AZ 85338.

22. The Republican Poll Observer told me that the tabulators rejected 25% of ballots and that at least one voter was given a ballot to “vote federal only.”

Estrella Foothills High School

23. On Election Day, at approximately 10:00 a.m., I visited the Estrella Foothills High School vote center, located at 13033 S. Estrella Pkwy., Goodyear, AZ 85338.

I, Shauna Bunker, state the following as my declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746:

1. I am a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Arizona.

Polling Location: LDS Church 495 S. Greenfield Road Gilbert, AZ 85296

I was a poll observer on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, for the 2nd shift from 1:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. I stayed for the complete finishing up of election workers. During the afternoon, voters were told they should wave their ballots around so the tabulator would accept it. (There had been problems in the morning-as reported to me by the morning poll observer.) There were two periods of time-30 minutes to 1 hour (around 2:00 and then again at 6:00) where tabulators consistently rejected ballots and voters would have to turn them over and try again and again. When ballots were not accepted by the tabulator, they were told to get a new ballot and try again or put their ballot in "Drawer 3" to be tabulated later. After 7:00 p.m., after the polls closed, 3-4 poll workers went over to the tabulators and emptied Drawer 3. They were counted. There were approximately 85 ballots-8 piles of 10 plus a few that I couldn't count the exact number. Poll workers began putting the Drawer 3 ballots into the tabulators, again over and over to try to have the tabulators accept the ballot. Two or three ballots were accepted by the tabulators when someone discovered that they weren't dropping into the correct bin. It was decided among the poll workers to phone the "trouble shooter".

The Inspector called and was told to put all of the ballots-tabulated and not tabulated-together in the black bags as all ballots cast that day would be audited. It took 3-1/2 hours to close up everything. I followed the vehicle to drop off the ballots.



5. I entered the voting area at 6:05 a.m.
6. There was one tabulator this voting center. I completed by ballot and attempted to tabulate it. The tabulator rejected by ballot.

7. I tried approximately five more times to tabulate my ballot, but the tabulator continued to reject it.

8. I was forced to place by ballot into Box 3. I was told by the election worker that my vote would not be counted until at least 8 p.m. on election day.

9. Nevertheless, when I went online 3:13 p.m on election day to check my vote status, the Maricopa County election website stated that I “voted on Election Day” and my “ballot was counted.” See Exhibit A.

10. Of course, my ballot was *not* counted because I was forced to put my ballot into Box 3.

11. Maricopa County confirmed this discrepancy. When I emailed Maricopa County to report this problem, Maricopa County stated that my Box 3 ballot would be counted the morning of November 9, 2022. See Exhibit B.

12. Maricopa County was unable to explain why my vote status stated my “ballot was counted” when in fact my ballot had not been counted.

I, Cherie Calbom, state the following as my declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746:

1. I am a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Arizona.
2. I worked as an Observer on Election Day at St. Nicholas Serbian Orthodox Church in Phoenix from 1-5 pm. From the moment I got there until I left, tabulators rejected more ballots than were accepted. I was told that both tabulators worked fine the day before when tested. They said calls were made to repair them but no one came. People were very upset. Many people tried multiple times to get their ballots tabulated. But most had to place their ballot in drawer 3, which they didn't want to do. One young man got in line 24 times with his first ballot. They would only allow him to try 2 or 3 times and then he would have to go to the back of the line and try again. I counted 24 times that he tried for ballot #1. Then he had that ballot spoiled and the same thing happened with his second ballot. I lost track of the number of times he tried to get that one through. Finally, he had that ballot spoiled and got a provisional ballot. The same thing happened with that ballot. He was still there trying when the Special Closer Observer came to take my place. This young guy was wearing "Let's Go Brandon" shirt. People were turned away all day long. They were telling them they should go somewhere else because of broken machines but no suggestions were given as to where to go. At 3:30 one tabulator Drawer 3 was so stuffed that ballots were spilling out. They had to open it and smash the ballots down. That was disturbing. These were peoples' sacred votes that were being treated like trash. One lady came in with a Federal Ballot she shouldn't have. She wanted a judge and no one would help her. Finally, the democrat observer knew who he was. She was the only one who would help her. Most of the poll workers did not seem friendly or helpful. In all, the entire time I was there was chaotic and disorganized and an all around debacle for voters.

1. I am over the age of 18 and competent to make this declaration.

5. On November 8, 2022, I volunteered as a roving attorney on behalf of the Republican National Committee's Election Integrity program in Arizona. In that capacity, I observed four voting centers experiencing several issues.

Central Christian Church/Mesa

6. At about 8:00 AM on election day, I arrived at the center located at Central Christian Church/Mesa, 933 N Lindsay Rd., Mesa, AZ 85213. I remained there until about 8:40 AM.
7. Upon my arrival, I was immediately advised by someone (not an elections official) outside the location, who likely thought I was going to vote there, that the tabulators were not working and that I should go vote elsewhere.
8. While I was at this location, both tabulators were not functioning. Poll workers were advising voters to go elsewhere to vote in person, but were still accepting drop-off ballots.
9. Eventually, this location swapped one of the broken tabulators for a functioning one.

Community of Christ Church

10. At about 8:45 AM on election day, I arrived at the center located at Community of Christ Church, 150 N Sulleys Dr., Mesa, AZ 85205. I remained at this location until about 9:30 AM.

11. At this location, I witnessed issues with the tabulators not reading several ballots.

12. I also witnessed poll workers attempt to work around printer issues by darkening the black alignment squares in the corners of the ballots by hand when they were not printing properly.

San Tan Village (Near Harkins)

13. At about 11:40 AM on election day, I arrived at the center located at San Tan Village (Near Harkins), 2270 E Williams Field Rd., Gilbert, AZ 85295. I remained there until about noon.

14. At this location, I immediately witnessed a long line of voters waiting to cast their ballots.

15. This location only had one functioning tabulator during my observation period.

Mesquite Groves Aquatic Center

16. At about 2:20 PM on election day, I arrived at the center located at Mesquite Groves Aquatic Center, 5901 S Hillcrest Dr., Chandler, AZ 85249. I remained there until about 2:30 PM.

17. During my observation period, this location had no working tabulators. I observed multiple signs around this location encouraging voters to go elsewhere to vote.


DECLARATION OF HAROLD DARCANGELO

I, Harold Darcangelo, state the following as my declaration pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1746:

1. I am a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of Arizona.

I was the inspector at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints - 10305 E Southern Ave, Mesa, AZ 85208, USA. We had problems right from the beginning with the tabulators reading the completed ballots. Voters were trying to get their ballots read and excepted multiple times (15-30 times) and the tabulators would not read them. One of the voters along with one of my poll workers noticed the ballot alignment marks were not printing dark on the ballots. The voter asked if they could darken the alignment marks on the ballot and when they did that the ballot read immediately and was accepted so a number of voters started doing this. It was a very slow process which resulted in very long lines. I realized it was a printer problem and called my troubleshooter and Poll Worker Hotline and told them what was happening and also asked for different printers. No one could help me. Finally, I got a call from tech support to change the printer settings from 20lb regular paper weight to heavy card stock. We got better results but still had problems with the tabulators reading the ballots. I don't know how many voters left because of the long lines and wait time. At one point in the afternoon, we had 275 people waiting in line. We closed our polling location at 7pm and put our Marshall at the end of the line. I believe we finished with the last voter at around 9pm.

We were told that there were two close locations but one was completely down. My husband and I stayed in line we checked in I filled out my ballot and I ran it through the machine it was rejected I ran it through both machines and it was rejected I then spoiled my ballot got another ballot waited in line saw many other people getting rejected ballots some were told to drop them in box number three. One man had to spoil his ballot three times. When it wasn't accepted an election worker told him that he had to fill in the bubbles for the judge selections has he left them all blank. So he went back and filled in bubbles for the judges because based on the information he got he thought that was mandatory and that was why his ballot was being rejected. The scene was utter chaos and very confusing and people were very upset. The entire process took me at least two and a half hours. There were also people coming into the voting facility not checking in because they just wanted to drop off a mail in ballot on election day, I saw many putting them into box number 3 as well. I took a picture of one of my ballots as I noticed that the ink on the ballot was faded in some areas I'm not sure if that's the reason why they weren't going through the machines.

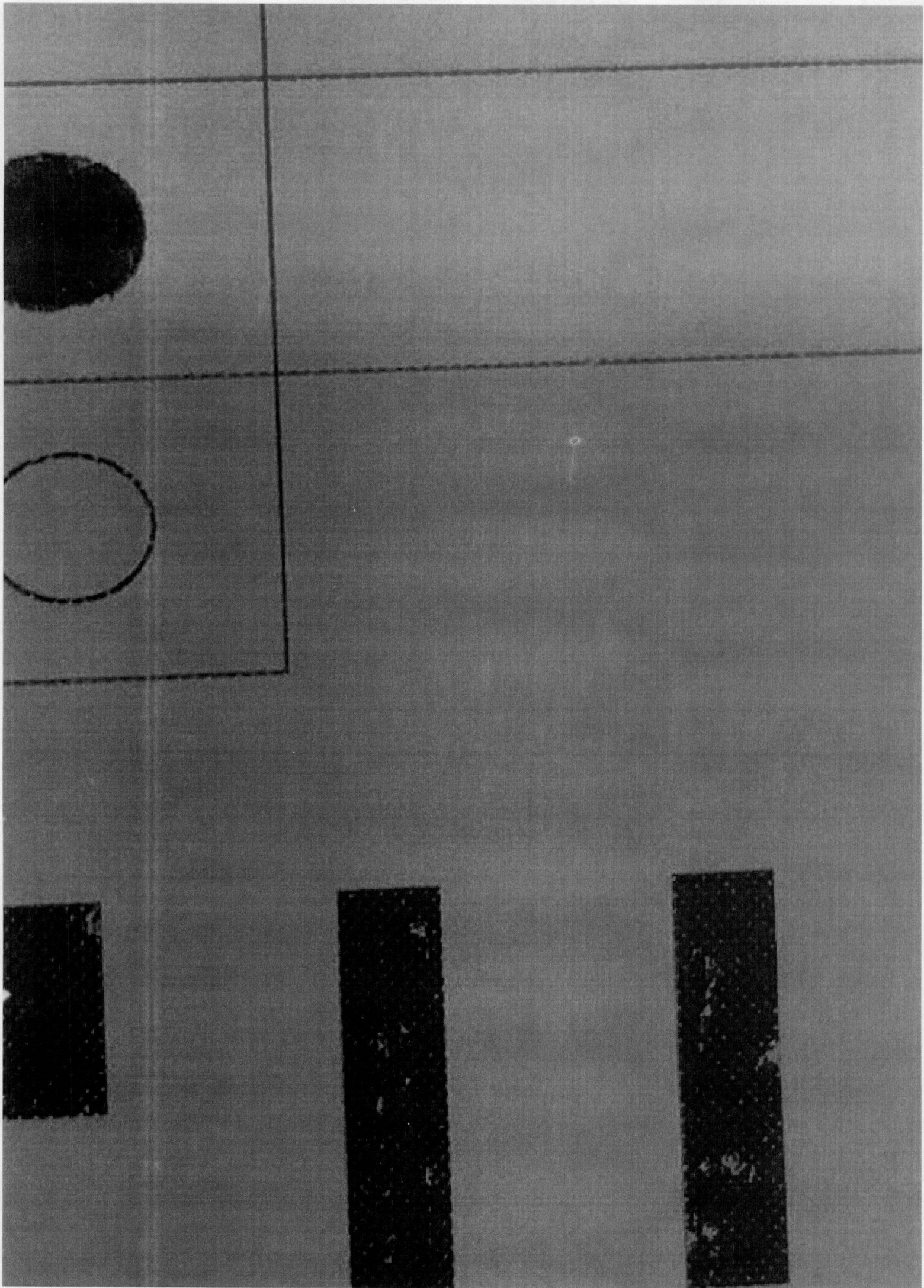

I voted in person at Central Christian Church in Mesa Az. The issue was not with the Site. It is with the automated printing software that generates a ballot after online check-in. I checked-in using my driver's liscence, scanned through a scanner at a computer terminal. There were many such terminals. It was not unique. The line to actually count the ballots was very long because one of the counting machines was down. So, many people had already voted, and were waiting in line to have their ballot entered. The polling staff informed people that one machine was broken and that it might be about a half-hour to actually have their ballot entered. Ballotts would not be entered if the voting party was not present. So there was a long line. I waited a while, then asked if I could cancel my ballot, knowing I would be late for work. I decided to come back later. A lady who worked the polling place walked me through the process that she thought would cancel the ballot. IT did look initially like the ballot would be "spoiled". We answered the questions pertaining to that process. However, due to what I think is a glitch, the ballot was never actually spoiled. It not only printed the original, but another one as well. So, I had two ballots in my name. The lady tried to "Spoil" the ballot again, and it looped through the registration process again and printed a third ballot. The ballots print in two pages, one is the name of the voter, the second is the actual anonymous ballot. The volunteers handing them out were checking IDs when voters picked-up their ballot, but there were so many people around that they would not have known if someone had waited around to pick up a second, third, or any number of ballots that had been mistakenly printed due to a glitch in the automated process that was supposed to "Spoil" a ballot. Wether intentaional or not, this is fraud. A single person, as long as they were not recognized as soming up to pick-up their printed ballot multiple times, could vote multilple times. I could have voted three times. I did not. I kept one of the printed ballots as proof and walked out with it.

At Dream City Church, two scanners; one broken; one only successfully scanning one in ten ballots. I was told, "Tech support has been called." TECH should be on EMERGENCY response time; I was there for a full hour trying to get my ballot scanned and they still hadn't graced the voting place with their presence. FIRST AND FOREMOST, identify why the scanner isn't scanning. IF you need to keep the black lines within the OVAL and not consider it a circle, PLEASE STATE THAT when you hand people the ballot. Let's resolve this before our next election, please. I, and hundreds of others, had no option but to place our ballots in the locked box for counting later tonight. This is NOT what I expect for my voting experience. Please fix this. It's inexcusable 1) broken scanner (did you test them before deploying them?); 2) tech support response (slow, if any response ever happens today at all); 3) Identify the intermittent scanning problem and if it is this, then INSTRUCT people WHEN YOU HAND THEM THE BALLOT that the scanner won't scan if you go outside the oval. Fix it. Technology should work. People should show up to fix broken technology. Voters should be able to scan their ballots real-time, on-site at the polling place.

My voting experience was atrocious. I will always remember this. This is about your nonfunctioning scanning equipment and lack of technical support to fix broken scanners. The election officials were wonderful, kind, and patient. Imagine how frustrated they must be. In all my years voting, only two stand out, and this far above the other interesting event.
